An architectural masterpiece, the Palais Bénédictine was built at the end of the 19th century by Alexander the Great, in honor of the Benedictine liqueur. Discover the history of the world's first spiritourism site.


It all began in 1510, when the Benedictine monk Dom Bernardo Vincelli created a secret elixir at Fécamp Abbey. The recipe for this panacea was lost during the troubled times of the French Revolution.

One day in 1863, Alexandre Le Grand, a Fécamp wine merchant, discovered the grimoire containing the composition of this liqueur in his grandfather's library. Intrigued, he decided to decipher it, and succeeded in reconstructing it after a year's effort.

The elixir became a liqueur he named Benedictine, in honor of the Benedictine monk Dom Bernardo Vincelli. He had the sumptuous Palais Bénédictine built to provide a prestigious setting for the liqueur's distillery (still in operation today) and its collection of works of art.

It's in the heart of the Palais that we can organize your event for 5 to 300 people. You'll find a prestigious and atypical Salle des Abbés, private lounges, an outdoor garden and a modern cocktail bar.

While the Palais Bénédictine is closed to the public, offer your guests exclusive moments in a princely setting.




On the A13 freeway towards Le Havre, take exit n°25 "Fécamp".












Salle des Abbés



This reception room, richly decorated with sixteen statues of the main priors of Fécamp Abbey and a prestigious stained glass window, will enhance your event.










The private rooms are bathed in natural light filtered through the original stained glass windows. High ceilings and detailed ornamentation lend a timeless charm to this space.






Le Jardin d'Alexandre




Find inspiration in this former art gallery featuring works by Andy Warhol, Henri Matisse and Pablo Picassos, to name but a few.
